Dear Friends and Loved Ones,

It has been nearly 2000 years since the greatest victory of all History, the Resurrection of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ from the dead! We always look forward to the many celebrations of Easter here in Russia, where we are once again safely "at home." Everyone here is also looking forward to the 9th of May, Victory Day, celebrating 70 years since the end of World War II.

We see many signs of prosperity in Russia. By just one metro station on the edge of St. Petersburg, we saw approximately forty new 25-storey high-rise apartment buildings that sprang up like mushrooms in the last few months. (They are even the color of brown mushrooms.) Here in Vyborg, there are several dozen new buildings, many new playgrounds, and construction is beginning to extend some of the new freeways in St. Petersburg closer to Vyborg. In NW Russia the population is increasing, people are coming our way, and our mission field is growing.
